

It will be the responsibility of all districts and staff to make a reasonable effort to educate, supervise, and nonitor appropriate usage of ordine computer network access to the Internet in accordance with this policy and consponding administrative rule, CIPA, COPPA, and the Protecting Children in the 21st. Suchts will not post or enail pescel contact information about themselves or other people unless it is inconjunction with a specific teacher approved assignment or approved college/career communication Students will not agree to meet with some one they have net colline without their parent/legal gradients approval. Students will promptly disclose to an achimistrator; teacher; or other school employee any message they receive that is in appropriate or makes them feel unconfinable. Employees will report any concerns related to their use of technology to their immediates upervisor.

Inividuals should not have an expectation of privacy in the use of the district's enail, systems, or equipment. The district may, for a legitimate reason, perform the following
