Although France represents itself as having a high level of national unity and integration, France has a large amount of its population involved in separatist movements that tears into the national fabric of the country. Divisions of class and religious divisions divide major sections of the country and cause political, economic, and social conflict, especially in the urban areas of the country. In terms of language, the thoroughly French-speaking areas of the country are confined to the north and in the Far East and southern parts of the country, local dialects dominate. These local dialects are distinctly different and hard to classify as French language.
